I cannot stress enough the importance of filling as many spots as allowed during the Protected sign-up dates (Feb 6-Feb 27th.) in order to maximize your volunteer

donation. More shifts = more money. After these dates it is a free for all in terms of shifts.

Recap of Required Volunteers for each day of each event:

- April 1- 60 volunteers from each school (8 adults/4 students per shift)
 - April 2- 55 volunteers from each school (8 adults/4 students per shift + 7 adults/students for clean-up shift)
 - April 15- 67 volunteers from each school (9 adults/3 students per shift + 7 adults/students for clean-up shift)
4. **Mandatory Parent Meeting, April 3rd** – If your student is going to be in the Band for the 23-24 School Year, then we will have our Mandatory Student/Parent Meeting. We will go over detailed dates and expectations for the upcoming year. We will also have the Show Reveal for the Fall 23 Marching Band.
 5. **Physical Day – May 3rd** – Save the DATE – This will be the Physical Day for All Students participating in the program for the 23-24 school year. The School is using a new system this year for our physicals. We are moving to a system called Rank One. This should be a positive switch for all our programs. Here is the link for more information:

 7. **Band Fee's** – We need to collect your Band Instrument Fee. **This Fee needs to be taken care of by Feb. 1st.** You will do this through the InTouch System that is attached to your student's account. This fee takes care of the repair and cleaning of the instruments. We need to send the marching instruments to get repaired and cleaned so they are ready for the spring and summer check-out.
 8. **Daily Grade Checks** – We will be taking Daily Grade Checks to see if our students have their Daily Materials. This includes the following: Instrument, Music, Pencil, Working Reeds, Towel (For Brass), Individual Tuners. We have been discussing this with the students on a daily basis, but it is not getting better, so we will now start taking grades. For tuners, here is the information of what to purchase – KORG TM 40 or KORG TM 50 are the standard models. Most of the students should still have these from their middle school days.

 11. **Early Morning Practice Available** – If your student wants to practice at school in the mornings. They need to be here before 7:15 A.M. They will be expected to be in a Practice Room until 8:15 and not wondering through the school.

Export the calendar



You can export your Charms calendar to a standard calendar file format (.iCal) or into a spreadsheet format (.CSV) which is compatible for school wires. If you prefer to sync the calendar with your mobile device calendar, you can do that as well.

Export to an iCal file

You can use this export file to import your calendar into Google, Outlook, Apple, or other electronic calendars.



1. On the **Main Sections** menu, click **Calendar**, and then click **Export**.
2. Click .
3. Click in the date fields, select the date range you want to export, and then click .
4. Open the iCal file and follow the prompts to import it into your calendar.

NOTE: The calendar events are uploaded to your calendar on the applicable date and include the name, the location, and the description of the event. You can open the event on your calendar and insert the event time as that information is not included in an iCal format.

Export to a CSV file


This export file is compatible with school wire file formats. The file contains the date, the event name, the location, and the description of the event.

IMPORTANT: If using this file with school wires, change the mapping preference to **CSV**, and change the **Map to** field option for **Start time** to **Ignore**.

1. On the **Main Sections** menu, click **Calendar**, and then click **Export**.
2. Click .
3. Click in the date fields, select the date range you want to export, and then click .

Sync to your mobile device calendar

This process syncs the entire Charms calendar with your mobile device.

1. On the **Main Sections** menu, click **Calendar**, and then click **Export**.
2. Click .
3. Expand your phone option and follow the instructions on the screen.
